1. Purpose of the document

This document regulates the framework conditions for performing the „**TTCN-3 CERTIFICATE**“ examination in Europe.

2. Preconditions for performing an exam

In order to conduct an identity check, a valid means of identification (personal ID, passport, driving license) must be presented prior to commencing the exam.

5. Framework conditions for performing an exam

The **TTCN-3-CERTIFICATE** examination may be performed either on a PC or in paper-based written form. The following information must be acknowledged by the exam participant before the exam begins:

- The exam will be performed as a Multiple-Choice-Test.
- Only one answer from the possibilities provided can be correct for a given question. This means that for each question only one of the possible answers provided can be selected.
- The number of points which can be achieved for a particular question is based on the difficulty of the question is shown with the question.
- The total number of points achievable for the exam is 41.
- At least 60% of the total number of points must be achieved in order to pass the exam.
- The exam lasts 90 minutes.
- It is allowed to ask questions about the conduct of the exam before it begins. Questions during the exam, (especially those relating to question content), are not permitted and will not be answered by the exam invigilator.
- The exam is closed-book. No supporting information, such as training materials, are allowed.
- The use of help, (hand books, notes, internet, etc.), is not permitted in the exam room during the exam.
- Mobile phones and other communications devices are not permitted in the exam room. Mobile phones must be switched off before the exam commences.
- Exam participants are not permitted to bring their own paper or writing implements into the exam room. The paper and writing implements provided by the Certification Body must be handed in when leaving the room and at the end of the exam.

- It is not permitted to communicate with other participants in the exam room during the exam.
- Participants recognise that the exam is confidential. The written or oral passing on, publication or repetition of the exam contents is not permitted.
- The following applies to paper-based exams:
 - Pencils may not be used.
 - Notes may only be made on the exam paper. Sufficient room for notes is available at the end of the exam paper.
 - Notes will be neither read nor evaluated.
 - The exam paper may be given in before the end of the exam.
 - The exam paper must always be returned.
- Visits to the toilet are not permitted during the exam.
- Exam participants must leave the exam room after handing in their exam papers or, at the latest, at the end of the exam.
