

BECOME AN ACCREDITED TRAINING PROVIDER

Accreditation is the quality assurance and maturity check for organizations wanting to offer training courses for the ISTQB® Certified Tester scheme .

Pre-requisite for an accreditation is the complete and cost-free submission of all required documentation to the GTB. Please see the

chart "Documentation to be submitted" for the specific materials required for the respective accreditations.

Differentiation between accreditations

Training Course Owner (TCO) The accreditation of course materials of an organization with regard to their conformity with the syllabus.

Training Course Provider (TCP) An organization which provides tutors and infrastructure (e.g., organization, marketing) for the performance of training courses and that provides training

Online Training Course Owner/Provider (OTCO/OTCP) An organization which provides the necessary infrastructure (e.g., organization, marketing) and resources for the performance of online training courses and that provides corresponding online training courses.

Prerequisites for accreditation

- > The content of the training course must be correct, complete and fully compliant with the syllabus and glossary.
- > Learning objectives must be implemented in the specified time and in sufficient depth.
- > Prerequisites for the performance of training courses are:
- a high-quality infrastructure
- relevant training experience and experience of the course lecturere in the field of testing
- Proof of the certificates of the course lecturers

THE ACCREDITATION PROCESS

Submission of the accreditation documentation (informal, but in writing)

Request accreditation checklists from the GTB Back Office

Reviews are performed by independent experts that are members of the GTB and make use of external support if necessary.

Accreditation denied – what now?

If an accreditation was denied, a new application for acrreditation can be submitted after 6 months at the earliest

¹The initial accreditation fee is due at application, independent of the result of the review. It is charged irrespective of the decision regarding the application, even if accreditation is denied or if the accreditation process is aborted. The fee must be paid again for each new application.

FAQ

Which languages can be accredited by the GTB?

> German and English

Who is responisble for review of the documentation submitted for accreditation?

> The GTB as national member board of the ISTQB®.

How long does an accreditation review take?

> The accreditation process normally takes a few weeks.

How long will an accreditation remain valid?

> 3 years. World-wide. Then re-accreditation is required. You will be reminded by the GTB to apply for re-accreditation 3 months before accreditation expires.

Is it permitted to advertise with the training scheme or to provide training courses without valid accreditation?

> No – without exception.
